












Samples for mineral oil – Advice for sample shipment

How to handle the samples?

What kind of sample	Amount/size needed	Packaging for shipment
Food e.g. solid, liquid, powder    	min. 50g	<p>glass jar/ PET cup with aluminium foil</p> <div> <div> plastic lid aluminium foil glass jar </div>  <div> aluminium lid aluminium foil PET cup </div>  </div> <p>Source: Packari.com GmbH</p> <p>Please note: Make sure that the lids are tightly closed and avoid using adhesive tape for closing.</p> <p>aluminium foil or polyamide bag</p> <div>  <div> Polyamid bag (Rilsan® bag, material: PA 11) </div>  </div> <p>Source: Tub-ex</p>
Packaged Food 	min. 50g	<p>aluminium foil</p> 
Packaging material e.g. paper, cardboard, plastic foil, jute bag, big bag  	min. 50g minimum size for migration test: 8.3 inch x 11.7 inch 210 mm x 297 mm (5 sheets)	<p>aluminium foil</p> <div>     </div>
